Policy on transporting children to and from matches

April 2020

It is not the responsibility of the coach or team manager to transport, or arrange to transport, the children to and from the club or match, apart from in the event of an emergency.

Parents/carers are responsible for the safe delivery and collection of their child for matches or training.

The fixture list is provided at the start of the seasons. This gives information which relates to all planned away fixtures or competitions to provide parents/carers with an opportunity to make appropriate arrangements. There are sometimes last minute changes to fixtures and these will be communicated to parents/carers with as much notice as possible.

Coaches and Managers will be responsible for children in their care when on the Club premises or on arrival at opponents' cricket grounds.

The Club will seek permission from parents/carers for children to participate in all competitions and away fixtures/events.

Pick up and drop off

Parents/carers should "pick up and drop off" their children to/from the Coach or age group Manager, and should always be prompt, if you are delayed the Coach or Manager should be contacted.

For away matches, a 'pick up and drop off' scheme can operate from the Club, whereby parents/carers give their consent for other parents/carers to transport children to away matches and return them to the Club.

Managers should always have contact details of parents/carers in case of late collection.

No child should be left alone at the Club before or after a match.
